Stallion Breeding Contract

This Stallion Breeding Contract is for the breeding season of 2012, is made and entered into on this date: _____

and is by and between JL Quarters and Paints, hereinafter designated as Breeder, and - _____, hereinafter designated as Mare Owner. The Stallion providing the breeding service under this contract is SK SKIP A CHICK AQHA# 4226658 . The mare to be bred for this contract is _____

Registration _____

- 1. Stallion Service Fees:** The stallion fee includes a Non-Refundable Booking/Chute Fee of \$100 payable with this contract, the balance of which must be paid with all other expenses when mare is picked up or when Mare Owner is invoiced, whichever is first. Invoices are payable upon receipt. Mare Owner may not remove mare from Breeder's property until all expenses are paid in full.
- 2. Mare Care:** Mare Owner agrees to pay \$450.00 as a breeding fee: 100.00 which is due at execution of this contract as a non-refundable booking fee. Mare care and feed at the rate of \$8.00 per day for dry mares; \$10.00 per day for mares with foals. Breeder agrees to provide care and feed for the mare and/or foal while in our care.
- 3. Condition of Mare:** The mare shall be in a healthy and sound breeding condition, free from infectious, contagious, or transmissible disease. A current negative Coggins Test (within 12 Months), updated vaccinations for Sleeping Sickness, Tetanus, West Nile, Rabies, Flu, and Rhino. Should be done before arrival . Also, the mares should be de-wormed prior to arrival. Foals over 90 days old must also be vaccinated. It is recommended that non-maiden Mares receive a simple Pre-Breeding Exam and have a Uterine Culture done if needed, prior to arrival. If they have not been done, and they are needed, Breeder may have exams, vaccinations, tests and/or treatments done at Mare Owner's expense. Most treatments and exams can be done at Farm to reduce cost. Breeder reserves the right to refuse mare if not in satisfactory condition, or send her home immediately if she is/becomes ill. If mare is refused or sent home, the Booking/Chute fee shall constitute liquidated damages. The mare may be returned for breeding, during the current breeding season,

after the unsatisfactory conditions have been corrected. This is for the health and safety of all horses on the farm.

4. **Safety:** Mares that are not halter broken, will not stand tied, or are otherwise difficult or dangerous to handle and manage will not be accepted. If the mare is a safety risk to herself or others, she may be sent home. Sedation may be given to mares that become a safety risk to themselves while being examined, etc. If your Mare has special handling needs, please discuss this with Breeder.

5. **A Current Copy of the Mare's Registration Papers**, front and back, showing Owner as the same person signing this contract, must be included with this contract. If this mare is not registered, Mare Owner listed must be actual owner and has the authority to breed mare. If the Mare has more than one owner, all Owners must sign Contract. Transfers and Leases should be completed prior to Breeding. . If mares are not vaccinated prior to arrival, then Mares will be vaccinated when they arrive, and before they are bred. It is Not Recommended to vaccinate broodmares during early pregnancy.

6. **Vet care and Breeding Services:** Breeder will exercise judgment in care and supervision of mare and/or foal. Breeder assumes responsibility for arranging vet and farrier services as is deemed necessary. Breeder's Veterinarian or Breeder will provide medical care when necessary for the health and safety of the mare and/or foal. Most, if not all, injections, treatments, exams and procedures will be performed by the Breeder to reduce the costs for the Mare Owner. All medical, reproductive, veterinary and farrier expenses will be paid by Mare Owner. Expense to Mare Owner will be kept at a minimum, but needed care will not be neglected. Vet check will be performed at the farm for the mare to determine pregnancy. This cost will be to the mare owner.. Mare and/or foal may be trailered to Veterinarian for examination and/or treatment. A fee of \$75 will be charged per round trip if she must be hauled to a vet for treatment/care. Typically, if a Vet is needed, exams and treatments will be done at the farm, and there will be a vet Farm Call fee. If Health Papers will be needed for travel prior to mare going home, then please advise Breeder a minimum of 10 days prior to departure so vet arrangements can be made. Mares and foals will be carefully supervised and given the best of care; however, the Breeder, their agents, employees, or guests will not be held liable for accidents, sickness, injury or death to mare and/or foal. Health and Safety comes first over all other activities.

7. **Live Foal Guarantee:** This contract contains a "Live Foal Guarantee". A live foal is described as a newborn which stands and nurses. If the foal is born dead, there will be return privileges for the 2013 season only. The mare owner is required to take the mare to the vet immediately to ensure that there is nothing wrong with the mare. The breeder needs to be contacted within 24 hrs of the foal if they are born dead. The copy of the vet report needs to be supplied to the breeder for the cause of death on the foal and the mare being checked by the vet within 14 days of the event. This is to ensure that the mare is taken care of immediately as needed as well as to help determine if possible the cause of death of the foal. If after being pronounced "safe in foal", the mare should miscarry, abort, or prove barren after leaving the Breeding Farm, Mare Owner has the privilege to return Mare or an approved substitute for breeding during the current breeding season scheduled to be from Feb 1, 2012 to June 30, 2012, or the following breeding season to be scheduled in 2013. Mare care applies to the time that the mare is at the farm for breeding. Breeder must be notified of death of foal, or miscarriage and receives a statement by a veterinarian confirming death. If mare fails to settle in 2012, she must be returned to breeder by the end of March 2013 to begin breeding again. Contract and Guarantee is between the Breeder and Mare Owner, and may not be honored if the Mare is sold or traded.

Mare must be vaccinated for Rhinopneumonitis (killed virus vaccine) during the **5th, 7th, and 9th month of pregnancy**. Annual boosters for Sleeping Sickness, Tetanus, Flu, Rhino, and West Nile are recommended to be given to mare approx. 30 days prior to foaling. Rabies and Strangles should be discussed with your vet. If you need advice on Vaccinations and Broodmare care, please ask Breeder or your vet. Vaccinations, De-worming, and Prenatal Care are the responsibility of the Mare Owner.

8. Breeder agrees to diligently try to settle mare; however, if mare fails to settle, for any reason, Mare Owner will hold Breeder blameless. Mare owner agrees to give Breeder ample time to settle mare---- breeding her through as many heat cycles during the season as necessary to produce a pregnancy. Mare Owner has the right to discontinue breeding if they choose, but no refunds will be given. **If the mare is confirmed in foal while with the breeder by ultra sound between 14 and 18 days after ovulation, it is strongly advised to have the mare checked again at day 30, as this is the most common time after a mare is checked as being in foal for their bodies to absorb.**

9. **Breeder's Certificate:** A "Breeder's Certificate" will be issued for eligible foal, conceived by this mating, when stallion breeding fee and all other expenses have been paid in full, and when mare has produced a live foal by this mating. The Mare Owner needs to notify Breeder when Foal is born. Photos may be required of

foal to determine color, especially if there is a Color Guarantee. The **mare owner agrees to properly register** the foal by 5 months of age. **PLEASE COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:** This will help us in management and individual care of your mare. The more information and history I can get on your mare, the better I can manage her successfully. Any and All information will be helpful, and appreciated. Include additional notes, or records if needed.

*** This contract represents the entire agreement between the parties. No other agreements or promises, verbal or implied, are included unless specifically stated in this written contract.

This contract is entered into the State of Oklahoma, and will be interpreted and enforced under its laws. If any clause in this contract is against state law, then that clause shall become null and void. When both parties sign this contract, it will then become binding on both parties, subject to the above terms and conditions.
